## **STEP 1: DOUBLE CHECK**

Make sure you have the following components available to complete the setup of your TV service.




### **STEP 2: CONNECT TO SET-TOP BOX**

- 1. Move the set-top box near to your desired TV.
- 2. a) If you are a new customer, plug the Ethernet cable from your Internet installation into the back of the set-top box.

#### OR

b) If you are replacing your set-top box, check if your connection has been set up via coaxial cable or Ethernet. Plug either cable into your new settop box. If using the coaxial cable, make sure it is threaded properly and tightly.




# STEP 4: SETUP REMOTE CONTROL

- 1. Open the battery cover by pressing down on the battery cover latch and sliding it off.
- 2. Insert the batteries, matching the + and marks on the batteries with the interior of the remote control.
- 3. Snap the battery cover to close.



# **STEP 3: CONNECT TO TV & POWER**

- 1. Connect the HDMI cord into the HDMI port in the back of the Set-Top Box.
- 2. Plug the other end of the HDMI cable into an HDMI port on your TV.
- 3. Plug the power cord into the back of the Set-Top Box and the other end into a wall outlet.



## STEP 5: TURN ON TV

#### Turn on the TV and select the correct video input.
