Features Guides





Local Conferencing

Your Poly Phone allows up to 3 parties (including yourself) to participate in a single call. This is referred to as a Local Conference Call or a 3-Way Conference Call.

To create a local Conference Call with up to two other parties:

- · Engage the second party by either calling them or answering their call.
- To contact the third party for the conference call, use the Function Keys and press More, then press Confrnc. This will automatically place the active call on hold and you will hear a dial tone.
- Dial the number of the third party you wish to add to the call.
- · Once the third party answers the call, using the Function Keys, press More and then press
- · All three parties are now joined in the Conference

To place an active Conference Call on hold:

- · Press the Hold key. The other parties will hear your Music on Hold recording.
- · To resume the Conference Call, using the Function Keys, press Resume.

Ending the Conference Call:

To leave the conference call but keep both other parties connected, hang up your phone or press End Call.

To end the conference call for all parties, press the **Split** function key. Press **End Call** for each line you want to disconnect.

To transfer an active call to another extension or external number using the

Blind Transfer:

- · During an active call, using the Function Keys, press and hold **Transfer**. This will automatically place the active call on hold and you will hear a dial tone.
- · Dial the number of the party you wish to transfer the call to.

Voicemail Guide

Initial Voicemail Setup:

Pressing *98 will start the initialization process where you will:

- · Setup up your PIN.
- · Record your Name.
- · Choose a Greeting (Personal or System Generated).

Local Access:

- · Press *98 on the phone.
- · If the Skip PIN feature is disabled, you will need to enter your PIN.
- · If the Skip PIN feature is enabled, you won't have to enter your pin.

Remote Access:

There are a couple of ways to access voicemail remotely:

· Call your main number and get transferred to

your extension:

- · Press the * (asterisk) key when you hear your voicemail greeting
- · Enter your PIN
- Call our remote access number: 519-243-9898
 - · Enter the number assigned to the phone extension followed by #
 - Enter the PIN followed by #

Voicemail Menu Structure:

- · Press 1 Hear/Review Messages
- · Press 2 Send Messages
- · Press 3 Greetings Menu
- · Press 4 Mailbox Settings (Skip PIN Feature is located in Security Options sub-menu).
- Press 6 Review Erased Messages
- · Press 7 Switch Account
- · Press 0 Help Menu
- Press * Help

Sidecar Module

Call Transfer with the Sidecar Module

The sidecar module supports one-touch blind transfer to other extensions or external numbers on the sidecar.

To transfer an active call to another extension:

· During an active call press the appropriate Extension key on the sidecar to which you wish to transfer the call to. This will automatically perform a blind transfer.

To cancel a transfer to a business group extension:

· After transferring the call, if the call has not been answered the status light next to the extension on the sidecar will remain flashing. Press the flashing Extension key to redirect the call back to your phone.



Call Transfer

Your Poly Phone supports two types of Call Transfers, both Blind (Cold) and Consultative (Warm) Transfers.

By default your Poly phone will complete all transfers as Consultative transfers. This can be modified in the phone settings (located using the Home key).

To transfer an active call to another extension/external number using the default Consultative Transfer:

- During an active call, using the Function Keys, press Transfer. This will automatically place the active call on hold and you will hear a dial tone.
- · Dial the number of the party you wish to transfer the call to.
- · When you are ready to transfer the call, using the Function Keys, press Transfer.
