

STEP 2: CONNECT ROUTER & ONT

- 1. Make sure all equipment is unplugged.
- Connect one end of the Ethernet cable to the Ethernet 1 or LAN 1 port on the ONT (port is different depending on the ONT model).
- Connect the other end of the Ethernet cable to the WAN port on the router.




STEP 4: CONNECT TV & PHONE TO ONT (if applicable)

TV SETUP:

- Plug an Ethernet cable directly into Ethernet port 2, 3, or 4, or Lan 2, 3, or 4 of the ONT, depending on the model shown.
- Plug the other end of the cable into your set-top box. If done correctly, the Lan 2, 3, or 4 light(s) will come on solid or flashing once set top box is powered on.

PHONE SETUP:

- Plug a telephone cable directly into the "Phone 1" port on either model of ONT, and the other end into your home phone.
- If you have two lines, connect the second line into "Phone 2" and the other end into your home phone.



STEP 1: DOUBLE CHECK

Make sure you have the following components in your High Speed Internet package.

Optical Network Terminal (ONT) & Power Adapter

You will have either the GPON - 812G ONT or the 716GE-I ONT with minor differences in setup. The technician will pre-connect the ONT to the fibre going outside your home.

Colours may not be exactly as shown.




Phone Battery Backup

Only included with a phone service



STEP 3: POWER UP ONT

Plug in the ONT's power adapter into the Power port, and the other end into a wall outlet. Ensure the pins in the power cable line up to the port or damage could occur.





If you are installing a Phone service, plug the ONT's power cord into the battery backup instead, then plug the battery backup into the wall outlet.

STEP 5: FINAL SETUP

- Plug in the router's power adapter and push the ON/OFF switch to ON and allow the router to boot up.
- 2. After four minutes the Power, Service, and Wi-Fi lights should be solid green or blinking on the front panel of the router.
- 3. Use your password to connect your devices to Wi-Fi.
